The Board of Directors of 2 Spirited People of the 1st Nations is pleased to announce the appointment of Kerrigan Beaver- Johnson as Executive Director. She will start on July 16th, 2017.

Kerrigan is a 2-Spirited Anishinaabe-kwe from Alderville First Nations with 20 years working with Aboriginal people, organizations and communities.

Kerrigan is a very seasoned leader with exceptional program planning, coordination, financial management, community development and public relation skills.

She was the Aboriginal Program Coordinator (2016) & Women's Community Program Coordinator (2015) & more recently she was Treatment Access Coordinator with the Prisoner's HIV/AIDS Support Action Network (PASAN). In the past, she has worked with both Women's College Research Institute and Mc Master University as a Research Assistant.

"We're very excited to have Kerrigan to join the team and to lead 2 Spirited People of the 1st Nations through its next phases," said Board Chair Monica Forrester. "She brings lots of experience, skills and passions that are an exact fit with 2 Spirited People of the 1st Nations needs."
